


NAVIGATING CLIMATE RISK

COURSE OVERVIEW

With climate risk as the central theme, this course aims to stimulate thinking and discussion about how climate risk is understood, what climate risk means in different contexts and how it can be managed.

To this end, participants will be introduced to the climate system, the importance of energy in the climate system, climate dynamics and the understanding of hazards. Participants will also gain a better understanding of the importance of context and how this influences the manifestation of vulnerability and risk to climate hazards.

Aspects of communication, behavioural change, ethics, values and choices related to climate change and risk will also be introduced.
